County announces changes in Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for The Kaua'i Bus

LĪHU'E – The County of Kaua'i announces the following changes in Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs) for The Kaua'i Bus service and administrative offices in order to provide for the health, safety, and welfare of the people of Kaua'i from the potential spread of the novel coronavirus (COVID-19).

Effective Monday, March 23, the Kaua'i Bus will be adjusting weekday bus service to be the same as its current weekend service hours. For the safety and health of all, The Kaua'i Bus appeals to all bus riders to use bus service for essential needs only.

Transportation Agency Administrative offices will be temporarily closed for in-person service. We will continue serving our clients by phone, email, or in special cases by advance appointment. The Kaua'i Bus phone number is 246-8110.
