Liquor Department educates youth on alcohol abuse and awareness

LĪHU'E – Liquor investigators from the Kaua'i Department of Liquor Control partnered with the Boys & Girls Club of Hawai'i, Līhu'e Clubhouse, on April 13, to educate youth on the dangers, effects, and consequences of consuming alcohol prior to the legal drinking age of 21.
