Update to Weliweli Road roadwork schedule announced

KŌLOA – The Department of Public Works and its contractors Maui Kupono Builders and Pacific Concrete Cutting and Coring announce that portions of Weliweli Road in Kōloa will be closed for road resurfacing until May 11.

Work hours are weekdays, from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., weather permitting.



Work continues on Weliweli Road, between Ala Kinoiki and Waikomo Road, from April 28 through May 4. During these dates, this portion of Weliweli Road will be fully closed. Traffic will continue to be detoured through Ala Kinoiki and Waikomo Road while work is being done.

Starting Thursday, May 4, lane closures and one-way traffic will begin for portions of Weliweli Road, between Kōloa Road and Waikomo Road. Traffic will be detoured through Kōloa Road and Waikomo Road during work hours. Work will continue in this area through May 11.

Motorists are advised to use alternate routes. No parking will be allowed in the work zones. Flaggers will be positioned on-site to help motorists and pedestrians navigate around the work zones. Access to properties will be provided.

Please observe and obey all traffic controls, posted signs, and flaggers. Drivers should anticipate detours, lane, and road closure delays and allow extra travel time while driving through the work areas.
