

Kaua'i residents can recycle household batteries free of charge at the Kaua'i Resource Center, 3460 Ahukini Road in Lihue. Monday through Friday from 7:45 am to 4:15 pm.

Acceptable batteries include:

**Alkaline** double-A, triple-A, C, D, 6 and 9-volt. **9-volts can pose a fire hazard.**

**Place duct or electrical tape on 9-volt terminals prior to recycling.**

**NiCad:** Used in hand-held power tools, solar lights, portable electronics, and cell phones.

**Lithium:** Used in consumer electronics, digital cameras, calculators, and computers.

Battery recycling at the Kaua'i Resource Center is for residents only! No commercial, No car batteries or computer back-up batteries. **Please sort batteries into the appropriate barrel.**
