A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. B-2023-891, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO THE OPERATING BUDGET OF THE COUNTY OF KAUAI, STATE OF HAWAII, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 2023 THROUGH JUNE 30, 2024, BY REVISING THE AMOUNTS ESTIMATED IN THE GENERAL FUND (*Fire Engine #5, Kalāheo Replacement - \$1,000,000.00*)

This Bill proposes to amend Ordinance No. B-2023-891, as amended, relating to the Operating Budget of the County of Kaua'i, State of Hawai'i, for the Fiscal Year July 1, 2023 through June 30, 2024, by revising the amounts estimated in the General Fund. This Bill proposes to transfer \$1,000,000.00 from the Equity / Fund Balance (Unassigned) to the Fire Department, Operations. The funding is required for the purpose of purchasing a new fire engine.

Any person may testify at the public hearing, and at any Council and Committee Meeting (at which time any Bill may be amended).
