

KAUA`I WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT BOARD

The 27-member volunteer Kaua`i Workforce Development Board (KWDB) is charged with policy and planning responsibilities and operates as a forum where business, government, labor, education, community-based organizations and the public work together to create an integrated market driven workforce system which sustains Kaua`i's economic growth and competitiveness by addressing the needs of employers seeking qualified workers, as well as the needs of eligible island residents for training to develop in-demand skills for current and future employment opportunities.

In cooperation with the Mayor, KWDB sets direction for workforce development utilizing as its foundation, the KWDB Strategic Plan, as well as the Kaua`i's CEDS Report, a prioritized set of EDA-eligible projects that reflect the needs expressed by stakeholders in the community.
