Bill No. 2744

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 12, KAUAI COUNTY CODE 1987, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO BUILDING PERMIT FEES

This Bill proposes to amend Chapter 12, Kaua'i County Code 1987, as amended, by amending Section 12-12.2, item number 20 (Section 108.1, Exception, International Building Code), to establish an exception from building permit fees for Additional Rental Units (ARUs) certified by the Housing Agency as affordable housing pursuant to Section 2-1.16, Kaua'i County Code 1987, as amended.

Bill No. 2744 is part of a package of six (6) proposals (along with Bill No. 2740, Bill No. 2741, Bill No. 2742, Bill No. 2743, and Bill No. 2745) intended to incentivize the development of Additional Rental Units (ARUs).

All interested persons who wish to present their comments may do so at the public hearing. Written testimony prior to the hearing would be appreciated. Written testimony can be submitted to the Office of the County Clerk, Council Services Division by mail, facsimile, or via E-mail to counciltestimony@kauai.gov. Copies of the Bill are available at the Office of the County Clerk, Council Services Division.

(The Council Committee or Council may amend this Bill at their subsequent meetings. Meeting notices are posted at least six (6) days in advance at the County Clerk's Office and the public may also testify at any of these meetings.)

**A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 12,
KAUAI COUNTY CODE 1987, AS AMENDED,
RELATING TO BUILDING PERMIT FEES**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE COUNTY OF KAUAI, STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 12, Kauai County Code 1987, as amended, is hereby amended by amending Sec. 12-2.2, item number 20, to read as follows:

“(20) Section 108.1 is amended by adding an exception to the first paragraph as follows:

108.1 Exception.

1. County facilities, except for the Department of Water, are exempt.

2. Housing projects or portions of housing projects that are developed to be affordable to low-income household as determined by the Housing Director or his authorized representative of the County Housing Agency shall be exempt provided such projects conform to applicable provisions of the County’s affordable housing program.

3. Housing projects or portions of housing projects that are developed to be affordable to gap-group household as determined by the Housing Director or his authorized representative of the County Housing Agency shall be exempt from one-half of the Building Permit fee, rounded off to the nearest dollar, provided such projects conform to applicable provisions of the County’s affordable housing program.

4. Additional Rental Units (“ARU”) pursuant to Article 30, Kauai County Code 1987, as amended, shall be exempt provided such ARU receives certification from the Housing Agency that the ARU qualifies as affordable housing pursuant to Sec. 2-1.16 of the Kauai County Code 1987, as amended.”

SECTION 2. If any provision of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of the Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are severable.

SECTION 3. New material is underscored. When revising, compiling, or printing this Ordinance for inclusion in the Kaua'i County Code 1987, as amended, the underscoring need not be included.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.
