Bill No. 2612      **A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER 14, KAUA'I COUNTY CODE 1987, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO THE PLUMBING CODE (This item was deferred to June 19, 2019.)**

Councilmember Cowden.


Councilmember Cowden: I honor waiting for Councilmember Kualii to come back.
