SUBJECT: **COVID EMERGENCY MEASURES COMPLIANCE INSPECTIONS**

Aloha Industry Members,

Recently, Mayor's Emergency Order #26 was released with measures which would apply to our industry in particular restaurants and bars. As part of this emergency order, the Liquor Investigators have been granted additional authority to enforce the rules set forth in the emergency order and to issue notices of emergency period infractions. With the rise of the number of COVID cases in our county, it is imperative that the alcohol industry members due their part in mitigating the transmission of COVID voluntarily to protect our community. At the same time, the Liquor Department also has a responsibility to monitor compliance with the Mayor's Emergency Order in locations licensed by the Department.

We ask you to please monitor employees and customers to ensure that the following rules are being followed.

- the wearing of face coverings;
- indoor and outdoor gathering sizes;
- guidelines for restaurants, bars, and social establishments;
- notifying and consulting with the County in regard to professional events and following County rules for those professional events; and
- restrictions on indoor capacity.

Beginning immediately, all Liquor Investigators have been instructed to regularly monitor all licensed location in the county for compliance and to take enforcement measures when necessary.
