### **Public Hearing on proposed amendments to Liquor Control rules set for Dec. 9**

LĪHU'Ē – The Liquor Control Commission of the County of Kaua'i will hold a virtual Public Hearing on Dec. 9, at 4 p.m., on proposed amendments to the Rules and Regulations of the Kaua'i Liquor Control Commission.

The proposed amendments involve generally the subjects of penalties, violations, digital signatures, electronic filing, trade names, use of assessed penalties, manager cards and required reports.
