

2020 GENERAL ELECTION BALLOTS

Līhu'e, Kaua'i – Ballots for the 2020 General Election will be mailed to voters of the County of Kaua'i on October 9, 2020. The majority of voters should receive a ballot within 4-5 days. Voters who have not received a ballot by October 16, 2020, should contact the Elections Division at 241-4800.

Ballot envelopes are easily identified by their distinctive purple graphic and the Official USPS Election Mail logo on the front of the envelope.



After voting, voters are urged to return their ballot as soon as possible by placing them in the USPS mail or depositing them in any of the following ballot drop boxes set up in the following locations:

Ballots can also be hand-delivered to the Elections Division, Monday through Friday from 7:45 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. On General Election Day, November 3, 2020, the office will be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Ballots must be received by 7:00 p.m. on General Election Day to be counted.
