Water service shutdown scheduled for Hanalei area on October 29

HANALEI – The Department of Water (DOW) announces a water service shutdown scheduled for customers located along a portion of Kūhiʻō Highway, north of the Waipa Stream to approximately Lumaha'i Beach Park in Hanalei, on Tuesday, October 29, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., weather permitting.

The water service shutdown is necessary in order to allow contractor, Hawaiian Dredging Construction Company, Inc., to tie-in a new water line to the Hanalei water system.

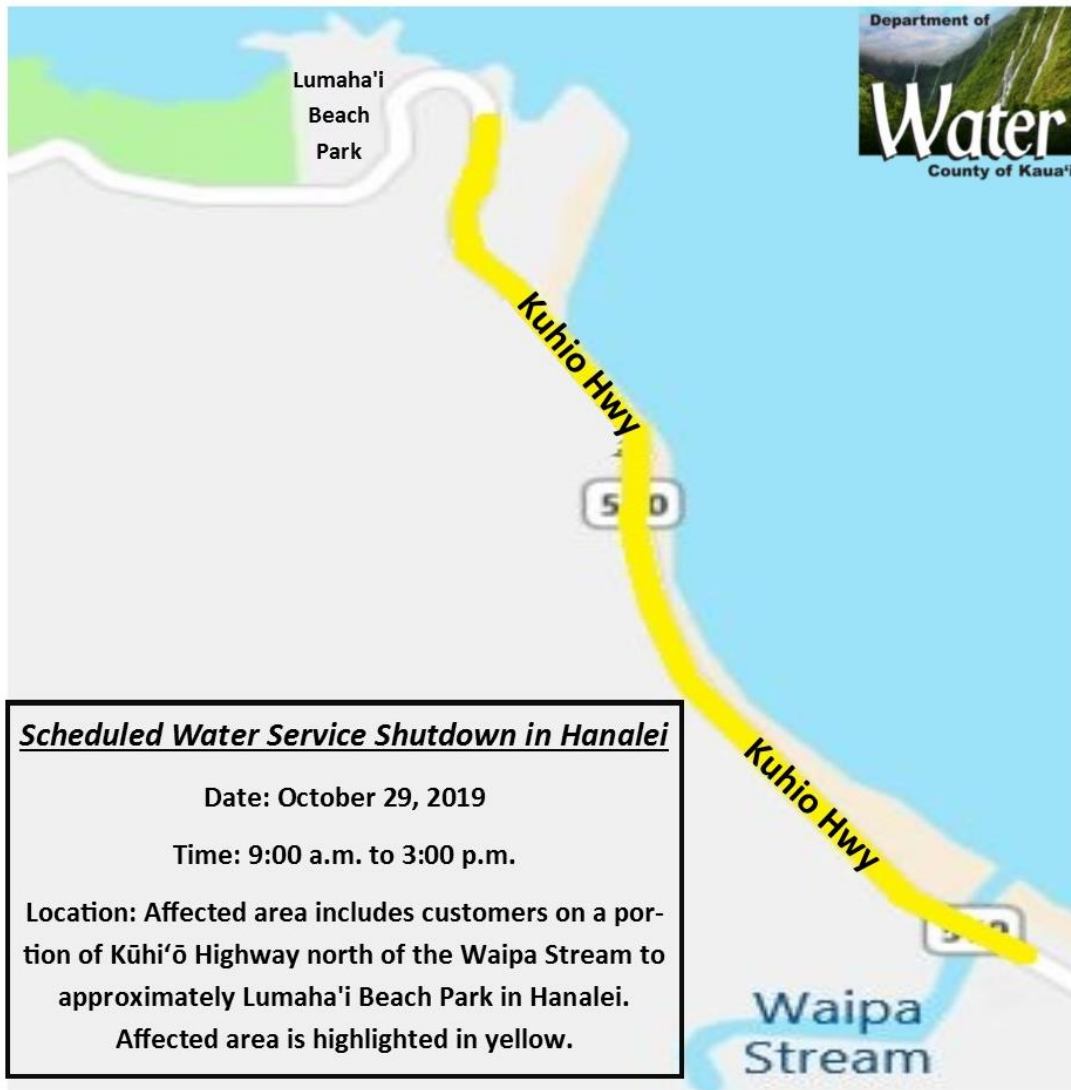
Customers located in the affected area are advised to prepare for the service shutdown by taking the following steps:

- Store enough water to meet your needs during the shutdown.
- Notify family, friends, tenants and neighbors that may be affected by the service shutdown.
- Those with faulty water heaters should ensure that water heaters do not empty during the shutdown.
- Businesses should plan appropriately prior to and during a water service shutdown.

Electronic message boards will be stationed along Kūhiʻō Highway between Waipa Stream and Lumaha'i Beach Park to remind customers of the scheduled water service shutdown.
