### **Public access to Motor Vehicle Registration, Drivers Licensing Division sections to close through April 30**

Effective through April 30, subject to extension as necessary, and pursuant to the Governor and Mayor's stay-at-home orders, public access to the Motor Vehicle Registration Section and Drivers' License Division will be closed through April 30.

The health and safety of our associates is our primary focus. This is also consistent with the County's messaging on social distancing and meant to encourage people to stay at home.

While expired safety checks will remain valid until May 31, 2020, under the Supplementary Emergency Proclamation done by the Governor, our online and kiosk avenues for registration renewals will not allow expired safety checks. If your safety check has expired in March or April, you will have to mail in your registration renewal to Motor Vehicle or use the drop box on the right side of the glass doors at the Kapule building.
