Focused workshops announced for West Kaua'i

LĪHU'E – As part of the West Kaua'i Community Plan process, a series of 10 workshops, focused on five topics, are scheduled for the Hanapēpē-'Ele'ele area, Waimea, and Kekaha. The first set of workshops are scheduled for Nov. 13 and Nov. 14. The focus will be on Shared Spaces which include parks, trails, and other gathering places.

“West side residents are the experts when it comes to how and where their communities can be improved,” said Deputy Planning Director Ka'aina Hull. “At the end of the day, this is their plan.”
