Search suspended for missing Līhu'e fisherman

WAILUA – The search for a Līhu'e fisherman reported missing Saturday was suspended Monday afternoon following a three-day, multi-agency effort.

Darall Pascua, age 55, is being reported as Kaua'i's sixth drowning for 2018.

According to a preliminary report, Pascua was standing on the reef in waters off of Marine Camp, near the Wailua Golf Course, while attempting to retrieve a fishing net about 50 yards from shore. A friend on shore lost sight of him and called 911 shortly before 9:30 a.m. on Saturday.

Pascua could not be located despite a three-day air, land, and sea-based search with a team of rescuers including Kaua'i firefighters, lifeguards, police, and the U.S. Coast Guard.

Police do not suspect foul play in Pascua's disappearance.
