Volunteers sought to assist with annual Point-In-Time Count

LĪHU'E – The Kaua'i County Housing Agency and the Kaua'i Community Alliance are seeking volunteers to assist with the annual Point-In-Time Count from Jan. 23 to 28, 2019.

The Point-In-Time Count is a real-time count of sheltered and unsheltered homeless persons on a single night and is required by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to access homeless-related funding.

“Volunteers will discover their own power to make a difference, and work with agencies serving the homeless population,” said Kanani Fu, Housing Director for the Kaua'i County Housing Agency. “The annual Point-In-Time Count provides critical data and information that will be used to enhance homeless services and to prioritize homeless related initiatives.”

To volunteer for the Point-In-Time Count, you must be 18 years of age or older to participate and be able to attend a mandatory Point-In-Time Count training on Dec. 19 at a determined location.
