COVID testing closed on Good Friday and Easter

LĪHUʻE – The County of Kauaʻi's COVID-19 testing will be closed on Friday, April 15, and Sunday, April 17, in observance of the Good Friday and Easter holidays.

The War Memorial Convention Hall testing center at 4191 Hardy Street in Līhuʻe will be closed Friday, April 15, and will reopen Monday, April 18. Normal hours are Monday to Friday, from 8 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. No appointments are needed, tests are free, international IDs are accepted, and results are provided within six hours.

The mobile testing van will be closed on Friday, April 15, when it is normally in Kalāheo. It will be open Saturday, April 16, at Hanalei Neighborhood Center from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. It will be closed Sunday, April 17, when it is normally in Kapaʻa. It will reopen on its normal schedule on Wednesday, April 20, at Kekaha Neighborhood Center and Thursday, April 14, at Kīlauea Neighborhood Center, from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. each day. No appointments are needed, tests are free, international IDs are accepted, and results are provided within six hours.

Lihue Pharmacy's free testing will also be closed on Easter Sunday, April 17.
