Sept. 23, 2015 Kauai County Youth Update

About Face classes are concluded for PY 14. This year we served 8 In-School participants and 8 Out-of-School participants. Enrollment and class completion are at 100%. We currently are case managing 63 participants, 27 In-School and 36 Out-of-School.

Much like the youth we service, Paxen/About Face is in a growth and transition state at this time. Site Manager Peggy Granda recently left Paxen to take another position on island, where she continues to share her talent and expertise in servicing the youth of Kaua'i. Malama Parent was hired as her replacement and is currently in training. We thank Peggy for all of her hard work and years of service, and for assisting during the transition period. In the upcoming PY 15, we will be servicing 5 Out-of-School participants with a start date in November 2015, and 5 In-School participants being enrolled in January 2016.

A beautiful partnership with McKinley Community School for Adults led to many of our newly enrolled participants graduating through HiSET at the Kauai Campus.
