Dear Chair Sanchez,

The plan submitted by the Kauai Workforce Development Board (KWDB) has been reviewed by a panel to ensure that there is alignment with the Hawaii Unified State Plan and the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA).

Attached are the revisions being requested by the panel. Each question has been reviewed to determine if the response was sufficient or deficient. If the response was deficient, there are comments by the panel requesting clarification, revision and in some cases attachments that are needed.

The plan must address how the KWDB will foster strategic alignment, improve service integration and ensure that the workforce system is industry-relevant, responding to the economic needs of the local workforce development area and matching employers with skilled workers. The four-year plan will be effective February 1, 2017 to June 30, 2020.
