ICan, ICareer Skills is changing from 120 hours of instruction and \$50.00 tuition, and will be offered as:
ICareer Skills - Module 1 English and Module 2 Math (Both English and Math Modules combined) (192 hours) \$825.00, or

ICareer Skills - Module 1 English Module (96 hours) \$425.00, or

ICareer Skills - Module 2 Math Module (96 hours) \$425.00

ICareer Skills is a fast track career and workforce student support program designed to help students improve their reading, writing, math and computer skills in preparation for a new career in the areas of. The This is a 192 hours instructional hours course. Students will have the option to receive career readiness training through a workplace-contextualized curriculum and achieve a National Career Readiness Certificate. To be eligible you must be 18 years or older.

- This is a hybrid model with online programs and direct instruction.
- ALL students will have the option of the following post-course pathways:
GED testing at McKinley Community School
KCC application, enrollment and COMPASS placement, FAFSA or
OCET short-term, non-credit, workforce training plan (at least one course)
Job search

Target Population: Individuals who DO NOT have a HS equivalency. Recruited through agencies only. Pre-course assessments must be minimum of 8th grade competencies.

New Courses (highlighted green):

Plumbers License Renewal (4 hours)

\$ 85.00 if course taken between 9/6/2014-3/7/2015, or
\$170.00 if course taken between 4/18/2015-6/6/2015, or
\$340.00 if course taken between 7/25/2015-11/21/2015

Effective with the June 30, 2009 renewal, all licensed plumbers will need to complete a continued competency requirement by verifying proof of attendance at an educational course on the current updates to the (2012) Uniform Plumbing Code (UPC) from Maui College, Hawaii, Honolulu or Kauai Community Colleges. This course will allow the licensed plumbers to meet this requirement in order to apply for the license renewal.

Electrical Technology Program (336 hours) \$5490.00

The Electrical Technology Program provides participants with the academic coursework required by Hawaii Revised Statute-HRS 448E for electrical apprentices. Participants gain foundational skills in applied math and electrical safety as well as the required subjects in AC/DC theory, motors and motor control, NEC, and transformers. This course fulfills requirements of HRS 448E, 240 electrical academic coursework.

Participants should learn applied mathematics, DC theory, ac theory, fundamentals of motors and motor control, fundamentals of the national electrical code, fundamentals of grounding and bonding, and transformer principles and application.
