

**A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE
TO AMEND CHAPTER 13 OF THE KAUA'I COUNTY CODE 1987,
AS AMENDED, RELATING TO THE ELECTRICAL CODE**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE COUNTY OF KAUA'I, STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 13 of the Kaua'i County Code 1987, as amended, is hereby amended as follows, and all other and prior ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed:

1. Chapter 13, Article 2, Section 13-2.3(a) of the Kaua'i County Code 1987, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 13-2.3 Application for an Issuance of Permit.

(a) Permit Required. No person, firm, partnership, association or corporation shall erect, construct, enlarge, repair, move, improve, remove, alter or convert any building or structure in the County of Kaua'i which requires electrical work or cause the same to be done, without first obtaining a separate electrical permit for such building or structure from the administrative authority.

Exception: [Permit not required for work in connection with meter and service wires installed by or performed by those electric and power service companies operating under franchise as public utilities and telephone installations.] Work performed for any Federal or State agency, except where permits are specifically requested by said agency."

2. Chapter 13, Article 4 of the Kaua'i County Code 1987, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Article 4. [Installation Requirements -] Adoption of the National Electrical Code

Section 13-4.1 Electrical Code to Govern.

The National Electrical Code, [2008] 2017 Edition, as copyrighted and published in [2007] 2016 by the National Fire Protection Association, One Batterymarch Park, Quincy, Massachusetts [02269-7471] 02169-7471, is hereby adopted by reference and made a part hereof, subject to the amendments hereinafter set forth as the standard for electrical work covered by this Code."

SECTION 2. If any provision of this Ordinance, or the application thereof to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of the Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are severable.

SECTION 3. Material to be repealed is bracketed. New material is underscored. When revising, compiling, or printing this Ordinance for inclusion in the Kaua'i County Code 1987, as amended, the brackets, bracketed material, and underscoring need not be included.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect ninety (90) days after the date of approval, but nothing in this Ordinance shall be construed to prohibit any person from complying with the provisions of the new code and the amendments thereto adopted hereunder.




