

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO
THE RULES AND REGULATIONS GOVERNING COMMERCIAL BOATING
ACTIVITIES AT COUNTY BEACH PARKS
PART IV

Pursuant to Section 91-3, Hawai'i Revised Statutes, notice is hereby given that the Department of Parks and Recreation of the County of Kaua'i will hold a public hearing on September 3, 2019, at 9:00 a.m., or soon thereafter, at the Līhu'e Civic Center, Mo'ikeha Building, Meeting Room 2A/2B, 4444 Rice Street, Līhu'e, Kaua'i, Hawai'i on the proposed amendments to the Rules and Regulations Governing Commercial Boating Activities at County Beach Parks Part IV.

The Department of Parks and Recreation proposes to amend its existing Rules and Regulations Governing Commercial Boating Activities at County Beach Parks by: 1) moderately extending the allowable hours of operation; 2) amending compliance and enforcement provisions to allow for incremental fines rather than automatic permit revocation; 3) minor non-substantive changes in formatting and language; and 4) clarifying the scope of commercial activity that may be carried out at the County's Weke Road Boat Ramp.

All interested persons who wish to present their testimony may do so at the public hearing. Written testimony prior to the hearing would be appreciated. Written testimony may be submitted to the Department of Parks and Recreation by mail, facsimile, or via e-mail to dagaran@kauai.gov.
