Please call (808) 241-4466 to arrange to reclaim the impounded property. You may produce the storage and disposal notice for the impounded property or provide a description of your property and the approximate date, time, and location where it was impounded. All items stored by the County related to the notice (or as described) will be returned after execution of a receipt attesting to ownership of the impounded property.

You may reclaim your property all at once or in multiple trips (so long as all your property is reclaimed within 45 days of being impounded).

Property owner shall be responsible for disposition of impounded property.
