Our vision at the County of Kauai Transportation Agency (CTA) is to improve and expand transit service for the community. Among CTA's goals are to better serve the mobility needs of both residents and visitors and improve the convenience, reliability, and cost-effectiveness of transit service. A Short Range Transit Plan (S RTP) was developed to achieve these objectives.

The following are some changes to our system in moving towards achieving goals identified through the S RTP:

- 1) New fare structure
- 2) Change in eligibility requirements
- 3) In-person assessments for ADA eligibility

Thus, the following fare structure and Senior age of eligibility (65 years) will be effective January 1, 2020 in accordance with County of Kauai Ordinance No. 1058:

PARATRANSIT

Senior registered (65+ yrs.)	\$4.00/trip
ADA registered	\$2.00/trip
10-Trip Ticket Book for Paratransit- Senior (65+ yrs.)	\$40.00
10-Trip Ticket Book for Paratransit- ADA	\$20.00

***Bus passes will no longer be accepted for Paratransit service effective January 1, 2020**

Monthly Pass- ADA, Seniors (65+ yrs), Youth (7 - 18 yrs.)	\$22.50
Annual Pass	\$500.00
Annual Pass- ADA, Seniors (65+ yrs), Youth (7 - 18 yrs.)	\$250.00

*** Note: Age of Seniors will be recognized at 65 years of age effective January 1, 2020.**
