C 2025-18 Communication (11/01/2024) from the Mayor, transmitting for Council consideration and confirmation, the appointment of Paul Gerard Toner to the Salary Commission – Term ending 12/31/2027. (Received for the Record.)

C 2025-23 Communication (12/10/2024) from the Fire Chief, requesting Council approval to apply for, accept, and expend a United States Department of Homeland Security (DHS), Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Assistance to Firefighters Grant (AFG), to fund the purchase of one (1) Type V Fire Engine, totaling \$352,727.00, to enhance the Kaua'i Fire Department's ability to better access and combat off-road, brush, and wildland fires.
