### WAI PĀ AND KĪLAUEA COMMUNITY AGRICULTURAL CENTER SITE VISIT *(Space is limited to the first 24 participants who sign up and submit payment)*

A tour to the north side of the Garden Island to Waipā and the Kīlauea Community Agricultural Center will be offered to conferees on Thursday, September 21, 2023 at 10:30 a.m.

The Waipā site visit includes a tour of Waipā’s Community Complex and the surrounding program, garden, retail/market, and shuttle spaces, and an opportunity observe poi being processed at Laukupu—its commercial kitchen/poi mill. Additionally, discussion will touch on the watershed and its natural resources and history of The Waipā Foundation, its background, goals and work, as well as Waipā’s relationship with and impact on its target communities and partners, and the evolution of its programs, activities, resource and facilities development, and management over the last 30 years.

Participants will then embark to Kīlauea Community Agricultural Center, which will include a luncheon from the abundance of the farm and a tour, inclusive of all the different systems for livestock, crops, and infrastructure needed to bring everything to market, as well as discussion of local challenges and economic structure of Kauaī’s food system and the inherent fragility of it. In addition, the traditional and contemporary history will be shared, which has led us to where we are and the potential that lies ahead for Kīlauea, Kauaī, and the State of Hawai‘i will be explored.

The site visit fee will include tour transportation, light lunch, and beverage. Please wear casual attire (tennis shoes suggested), have appropriate sun protection, and bring a water bottle.

Please meet in the Kōloa Landing Resort Lobby area by 8:15 a.m. Buses will leave promptly at 8:30 a.m.

### HANAPĒPĒ SALT PANS SITE VISIT AND TALK STORY SESSION SPOTLIGHTING NI‘IHAU AT SALT POND BEACH PARK *(Space is limited to the first 24 participants who sign up and submit payment)*

A tour to the west side of the Garden Island to the Hanapēpē Salt Pans and talk story session spotlighting Niihau will be offered to conferees on Thursday, September 21, 2023 at 10:00 a.m.

Ku‘ulei Santos and her ‘ohana will share the history, legends, and ancient techniques of harvesting *pa‘akai* (Hawaiian sea salt) and its importance to the Hawaiian culture, which has been passed down from generation to generation.

Participants will then head over to the Salt Pond Beach Park to enjoy lunch, and may even get a clear view of Niihau, also known as the “Forbidden Island.” Representatives of Niihau will share interesting facts about Niihau, along with a visual display via jewelry-making, *mele*, and hula.

The site visit fee will include tour transportation, light lunch, and beverage. Please wear casual attire and be prepared to go barefoot (“slippahs” are suggested)! It is encouraged that you also have appropriate sun protection and bring a water bottle.
