Bill No. 2832

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 5, SECTION 5-2.4, KAUAI COUNTY CODE 1987, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE CERTIFICATE OF OWNERSHIP AND REGISTRATION FEES

The purpose of this Bill is to amend Chapter 5, Section 5-2.4, Kaua'i County Code 1987, as amended, relating to Motor Vehicle Certificate of Ownership and Registration Fees, to increase the fee for new and duplicate certificates of title and registration and to increase the fee charged for duplicate emblems. The current fees do not cover the costs incurred by the County for materials and labor.

Bill No. 2833

A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 17, SECTION 17-1.1 KAUAI COUNTY CODE 1987, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO THE GENERAL PROVISIONS RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC REGULATIONS

The purpose of this Bill is to amend Chapter 17, Section 17-1.1, Kaua'i County Code 1987, as amended, relating to driver licensing fees. The driver's licensing fees have not been changed in twelve (12) years and are comparably low to other counties throughout the state. The current fees do not cover the costs incurred by the County to administer the services and functions of the driver licensing division. All fees go directly to the general fund.

All interested persons who wish to present their comments may do so at the public hearing. Written testimony prior to the hearing would be appreciated. Written testimony can be submitted to the Office of the County Clerk, Council Services Division by mail, facsimile, or via E-mail to counciltestimony@kauai.gov. Copies of these Bills are available at the Office of the County Clerk, Council Services Division.

(The Council Committee or Council may amend these Bills at their subsequent meetings. Meeting notices are posted at least six (6) days in advance at the County Clerk's Office and the public may also testify at any of these meetings.)

**A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 5, SECTION 5-2.4,
KAUAI COUNTY CODE 1987, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO MOTOR
VEHICLE CERTIFICATE OF OWNERSHIP AND REGISTRATION FEES**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE COUNTY OF KAUAI, STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The purpose of this Ordinance is to amend Chapter 5, Section 5-2.4, Kaua'i County Code 1987, as amended, relating to Motor Vehicle Certificate of Ownership and Registration Fees, to increase the fee for new and duplicate certificates of title and registration and to increase the fee charged for duplicate emblems. The current fees do not cover the costs that the County currently incurs for materials and labor.

SECTION 2. Chapter 5, Section 5-2.4, Kaua'i County Code 1987, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 5-2.4 Motor Vehicle Certificate of Ownership and Registration Fees.

The Director of Finance shall charge and collect fees for the issuance of motor vehicle certificate of ownership and registration as follows:

(a) Corrections on the certificate of registration and certificate of ownership, Sec. 286-51, H.R.S., shall be charged a fee of five dollars (\$5.00).

(b) Each new certificate of title issued by the Director of Finance under Sec. 286-55, H.R.S., shall be charged a fee of [five dollars (\$5.00).] ten dollars (\$10.00).

(c) Duplicate certificates of title and registration, which are furnished under Sec. 286-55, H.R.S., shall be charged a fee of [five dollars (\$5.00).] ten dollars (\$10.00).

(d) Motor vehicle plates issued to manufacturers or dealers under Sec. 286-53, H.R.S., shall be charged a fee of thirty dollars (\$30.00) for the life of the plates.

(e) Motor vehicle plates issued under Section 249-7, H.R.S., shall be charged a fee of five dollars (\$5.00).

(f) Duplicate emblems issued pursuant to Section 249-8, H.R.S., shall be charged a fee of [fifty cents (\$0.50).] one dollar (\$1.00).

(g) There shall be a County of Kaua'i registration fee for each new and renewal of motor vehicle registration of [seventeen dollars (\$17.00).] twenty dollars (\$20.00)."

SECTION 3. Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance or application thereof to any person, persons, or circumstances is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are severable.

SECTION 4. Ordinance material to be repealed is bracketed. New Ordinance material is underscored. When revising, compiling, or printing this Ordinance for inclusion in the Kaua'i County Code 1987, as amended, the brackets, bracketed material, and underscoring shall not be included.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its approval.



**A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 17, SECTION 17-1.1
KAUAI COUNTY CODE 1987, AS AMENDED, RELATING TO THE
GENERAL PROVISIONS RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLES AND
TRAFFIC REGULATIONS**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE COUNTY OF KAUAI, STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 17, Section 17-1.1, Kaua'i County Code 1987, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 17-1.1 Fees.

(a) The following fees are established for issuance and renewal of motor vehicle operator licenses and permits:

(1) Instruction permits: ten dollars (\$10.00).

(2) Issuance and renewal of operator's license which shall expire on the eighth (8th) birthday of the licensee following the date of issuance of the license (all operators from age twenty-five ~~[[25]] (25)~~ to seventy-one ~~[[71]] (71)~~ years of age): ~~[thirty-two dollars (\$32.00).]~~ forty dollars (\$40.00).

(3) Issuance and renewal of operator's license which shall expire on the fourth (4th) birthday of the licensee following the date of issuance of the license (all operators sixteen ~~[[16]] (16)~~ to twenty-four ~~[[24]] (24)~~ years of age): ~~[sixteen dollars (\$16.00).]~~ twenty dollars (\$20.00).

(4) Issuance and renewal of operator's license which shall expire on the second (2nd) birthday of the licensee following the date of issuance of the license (all operators from seventy-two ~~[[72]] (72)~~ years of age or older): ~~[eight dollars (\$8.00).]~~ ten dollars (\$10.00).

(5) Issuance and renewal of operator's license valid for one (1) year shall expire on the first (1st) birthday of the licensee following the date of issuance of the license: ~~[four dollars (\$4.00).]~~ five dollars (\$5.00).

(6) Duplicate license and duplicate instruction permit: ~~[seven dollars (\$7.00).]~~ ten dollars (\$10.00).

(7) Reinstatement fee for suspended license: ~~[thirty dollars (\$30.00).]~~ sixty dollars (\$60.00).

(8) Clearance or verification letters: ~~[five dollars (\$5.00).]~~ ten dollars (\$10.00).

(b) A fee of six dollars (\$6.00) is established for the examination of drivers applying for an operator's license. This fee is not chargeable if the applicant presents evidence of having paid to Kaua'i County the instruction permit fee. In addition, the following fees are established for drivers applying for each step of upgrade in an operator's license:

(1) The following fees are established for each road test given to applicants:

(A) For category type one, two, or three: ten dollars (\$10.00).

(B) For category type four: fifty dollars (\$50.00).

(2) There shall be established a test fee of [two dollars (\$2.00)] ten dollars (\$10.00) for each written or oral exam taken by applicants[.], including for electronically administered written or oral exams.

[(3) There shall be established a test fee of ten dollars (\$10.00) for each oral test given for types one, two and three.]”

SECTION 2. Severability. If any provision of this Ordinance or application thereof to any person, persons, or circumstances is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect the other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are severable.


