RESOLUTION PROPOSING A CHARTER AMENDMENT RELATING TO A HOUSING DEVELOPMENT FUND

This Resolution proposes to amend the Kaua'i County Charter, Article XIX, Financial Procedures, Section 19.15, Fund Administration, by establishing a new paragraph D, Housing Development Fund, and to earmark a minimum of two percent (2%) of the certified real property tax revenues to the Housing Development Fund for the purpose of affordable housing.

If this Resolution is adopted by the Kaua'i County Council, this proposed amendment will be submitted for a vote by the electorate on the 2022 General Election ballot.

All interested persons who wish to present their comments may do so at the public hearing. Written testimony prior to the hearing would be appreciated. Written testimony can be submitted to the Office of the County Clerk, Council Services Division by mail, facsimile, or via E-mail to counciltestimony@kauai.gov. RESOLUTION PROPOSING A CHARTER AMENDMENT RELATING TO A HOUSING DEVELOPMENT FUND

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE COUNTY OF KAUA'I, STATE OF HAWAI'I:

SECTION 1. Pursuant to Section 24.01 of the Charter of the County of Kaua'i (hereinafter "Charter"), the Council hereby resolves to submit the Charter Amendment described in this Resolution to the voters of the 2022 General Election.

SECTION 2. Section 19.15, Article XIX, Charter, is hereby amended by establishing a new paragraph D as follows:

"D. Housing development fund.

1. In adopting the annual operating and capital programs budgets, the council shall appropriate a minimum of two percent (2.0%) of the certified real property tax revenues to the housing development fund. In any fiscal year, the council may make appropriations to the housing development fund in addition to the two percent (2.0%) required herein.

2. On an annual basis, no more than five percent (5%) of this fund shall be used for administrative expenses.

<u>3.</u> Any unencumbered balance in this fund at the end of each fiscal year shall not lapse, but shall remain in the fund, accumulating from year to year. Any unencumbered balance in this fund shall not be used for any purpose except those listed in paragraph 1 of this Section.

<u>4. The council shall by ordinance establish procedures for the administration and expenditure of the revenues in this fund.</u>"

SECTION 3. All material is new. If this amendment is adopted by voters, the County Clerk need not show any underlining for inclusion in the Charter.

SECTION 4. The County Attorney and County Clerk shall approve the wording of the ballot question, which shall be substantially in the following form:

"Shall two percent (2%) of real property tax revenues be earmarked for the purpose of affordable housing?"

SECTION 5. Upon adoption of this Resolution by five or more Councilmembers after two readings on separate days, the County Clerk and County Attorney shall take the necessary steps to submit this amendment to the voters.
