Portion of Ala Kalanikaumaka to be closed Feb. 25 to March 4

KŌLOA - The Department of Public Works and its contractor Maui Kupuno Builders are announcing that Ala Kalanikaumaka, from Lopaka Paipa Boulevard to Ala Kukuiula, in Kōloa will be closed from Feb. 25 to March 4, on weekdays, from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., weather permitting.

The closure is necessary for road resurfacing work.

Motorists heading southbound from the Kōloa Roundabout will be detoured to Lopaka Paipa Boulevard and Poʻipū Road. Residents and visitors accessing Kukuiula will be detoured around the closure to the Poʻipū Roundabout and Ala Kukuiula. Motorists wishing to travel northbound from the Poʻipū Roundabout to Kōloa Road should take Poʻipū Road or use alternate routes.

Signs and Flaggers will be positioned along the closure to detour traffic around the work zone.

During this time, no parking will be allowed in the work zones.

Please make the appropriate arrangements to accommodate the necessary road closures, detours, and adjusted traffic flow. Use alternate routes and allow for extra time to get to destinations.
