Online registration for Summer Fun program begins May 16

LĪHU'E – The Department of Parks and Recreation announces that registration for the county's Summer Fun will begin on May 16 at 8 a.m. is on the county's website, <u>https://recreation.kauai.gov</u>.

Due to a recent software upgrade, we encourage everyone to create a household account or update their current account before May 16 by visiting the website above. The Summer Fun program runs from June 13 to July 22, on weekdays, from 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., and is open to children 5 to 11 years old. In observance of the Independence Day holiday, there will be no summer fun program on Monday, July 4.

Program sites include the Kīlauea, Kapa'a, Līhu'e, Kalāheo, Hanapēpē, Waimea, and Kekaha neighborhood centers, as well as the Anahola Clubhouse.

The cost of enrollment is \$75 per child and includes lunch.

All major credit cards will be accepted for payment, including American Express, Master Card, VISA, and Discover. In addition, debit and pre-paid credit cards will be accepted.

Enrollment is limited and will be handled on a first-come, first-served basis.
