Lane closures on 'Akuli Street and Hanamā'ulu Road near King Kaumuali'i Elementary School scheduled from June 6 to June 17

HANAMĀ'ULU – The Department of Public Works and Goodfellow Bros. LLC., are announcing

that sections of 'Akuli Street and Hanamā'ulu Road will be under short lane closures from June 6 to June

17, on weekdays, from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

There will be no work on Friday, June 10, in observance of the King Kamehameha Day Holiday.

These closures are necessary for improvements to pedestrian access to the school, including

new sidewalks, crosswalks, and ADA ramps.

Expect occasional brief delays. As a reminder, the speed limit is 15 mph near King Kaumuali'i

Elementary school while school is in session.
