## Lane closures scheduled for portions of Po'ipū Road from Oct. 14 to Oct. 19

PO'IPŪ – The Department of Public Works and its contractor Maui Kupono Builders are announcing that portions of Po'ipū Road will be closed Oct. 14 to Oct. 19, weekdays, from 8 a.m. to 4:30

p.m., weather permitting.


The lane closures are necessary for road resurfacing work. No road work will occur during the peak traffic times for school drop-off.

Lane closures will occur during the following locations and dates:

- Po'ipū Road, between Koloa Road and the Po'ipū Road Roundabout, Oct. 14 to Oct. 18. This
  portion of Po'ipū Road will experience closures in both directions at times. Motorists will be
  detoured around the work zone through Lopaka Paipa Boulevard.
- Po'ipū Road, between Ala Kinoiki and Ainako Street (near the Grand Hyatt), Oct. 18 and Oct. 19.
   One lane will remain open to accommodate alternating traffic in both directions.

Please make the appropriate arrangements to accommodate the necessary road closures, use alternate routes, and allow extra time to get to destinations. During this time, no parking will be allowed in the work zones. Flaggers will be positioned at both ends of the work zone to direct traffic.
