## Mayor Kawakami, County Council sworn into office on Thursday

LĪHU'E – The Inauguration Ceremony for Mayor Derek S.K. Kawakami and the 2022-2024 Kaua'i County Council took place at the Kaua'i War Memorial Convention Hall on Thursday. Judge Jonathan J. Chun swore in Mayor Kawakami – who will serve a second term – and the new County Council members.

"We are proud of our work in our first term. While many chapters in our journey are complete, we have much more that lies ahead," said Mayor Kawakami. "With four years left, our Administration intends to finish what we started. We thank you from the bottom of our hearts for partnering with us to continue the good work for the people of Kaua'i and Ni'ihau."


