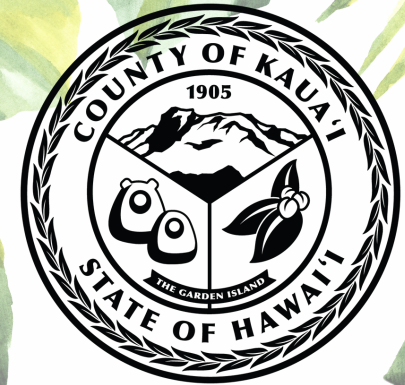

What is the FSS Program?

The FSS Program is a five year, voluntary program available to Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher participants designed to assist residents who are committed to achieving economic self-sufficiency. The FSS program is self-paced. The participant determines the goals and the coordinator helps find the resources needed to achieve those goals.

Who can participate?

To qualify, a family or individual must be a voluntary participant in the KCHA Section 8 HCV Program with a commitment to becoming self-sufficient.



How does the FSS Program work?



FSS Application

Complete the FSS application. You may be placed on a waitlist depending on available slots.



Intake Meeting with FSS Staff

Develop your short and long-term goals and sign an FSS Contract of Participation.



Attend Workshops

Attend workshops and receive referral services needed.



Meet with FSS Coordinator

Periodically meet with your FSS Coordinator to review and discuss progress, goals and additional services needed.



Graduate with Escrow!

Apply for graduation after completing goals and fulfilling CoP.

ESCROW SAVINGS

Financial Incentive!

FSS participants build a tax-free escrow savings account when their rent rises due to increased earned income, and graduates receive the full balance to use as they wish.
