

<a href="#">HB1594 HD1</a>	Intoxicating Liquor; Operating a Vehicle Under the Influence; Public Consumption; Purchase; Prohibition	RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR.	Prohibits any person convicted of operating a vehicle under the influence of an intoxicant or habitually operating a vehicle under the influence of an intoxicant from purchasing or publicly consuming alcohol for a certain period. Effective 7/1/3000. (HD1)
<a href="#">HB1672</a>	Intoxicating Liquor; Dancing; Police Powers; Dispenser Licenses; Licensees; Felonies; Standard Bar; Obstruction; Inspection	RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR.	Removes the regulation of dancing on licensee premises from the jurisdiction of liquor commissions. Repeals the grant of police powers upon liquor commission investigators. Repeals a category for dispenser licenses in which employees sit with patrons. Repeals the prohibition on the issuance of cabaret licenses in certain areas. Limits the prohibition on the issuance of licenses to persons convicted of a felony to when the felony was committed within the preceding ten years. Repeals the condition for standard bars to provide music and dancing only if the business is located in a commercial district and obtains a temporary approval. Repeals language punishing obstruction of liquor investigators and authorizing investigators to forcibly enter licensee premises. Repeals the general right to inspection by liquor investigators.
<a href="#">SB2096</a>	Liquor Tax; Cooler Beverages; Small Brewer Tax	RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR.	Includes certain spirits-based beverages in the definition of cooler beverage. Establishes a separate tax rate for qualified small brewers.
<a href="#">HB1783</a>	Transportation; Electronic Credentials; Identification; Driver's Licenses; Civil Identification Cards	RELATING TO IDENTIFICATION CARDS.	Authorizes and establishes a regulatory framework for the issuance, use, and acceptance of electronic credentials.

<a href="#">SB2354</a>	Alcohol; Beer; Liquor Law; Brewpubs	RELATING TO ALCOHOL.	Expands the definition of "beer" under the liquor regulatory laws to mean any alcoholic beverage containing no less than 0.5 per cent alcohol by volume obtained by fermentation of any infusion or decoction of malt or any substitute, including alcohol seltzer beverages and excluding sake, cooler beverages, and other distilled products. Authorizes brewpubs to sell beer they manufacture, or beer manufactured on their premises, subject to certain conditions. Effective 1/1/2025.
<a href="#">SB2690 SD1</a>	Intoxicating Liquor; Operating a Vehicle Under the Influence; Public Consumption; Purchase; Prohibition	RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR.	Prohibits any person convicted of operating a vehicle under the influence of an intoxicant or habitually operating a vehicle under the influence of an intoxicant from purchasing or publicly consuming alcohol for a certain period. Takes effect 1/1/2050. (SD1)
<a href="#">SB2384</a>	Blood Alcohol Concentration; Driving Under the Influence; Motor Vehicles; Alcohol	RELATING TO THE USE OF INTOXICANTS WHILE OPERATING A	Lowens the blood alcohol concentration threshold for driving while under the influence of alcohol from 0.08 to 0.05.
<a href="#">SB2929</a>	Blood Alcohol Concentration; Driving Under the Influence; Motor Vehicles; Alcohol	RELATING TO THE USE OF INTOXICANTS WHILE OPERATING A	Lowens the blood alcohol concentration threshold for driving while under the influence of alcohol from 0.08 to 0.05.
<a href="#">HB2206</a>	Liquor Liability Insurance; Liquor License; Requirements	RELATING TO LIQUOR INSURANCE.	Removes the requirement that establishments holding specific classes of liquor licenses maintain liquor liability insurance.
<a href="#">HB2207</a>	Liquor; Wineries; Brewpubs; Small Craft Producer Pubs; Authorized Solicitors; Representatives; Permits; Place of Business	RELATING TO LIQUOR.	Authorizes persons to apply for a permit to act as solicitors or representatives of licensed wineries, brewpubs, and small craft producer pubs any county of the State.
<a href="#">HB2209</a>	Liquor License; Class 10	RELATING TO LIQUOR LICENSES.	Authorizes liquor sold through a class 10 license to be consumed on or off the premises.

<a href="#">SB2457</a>	Liquor Licenses; Renewal; Protest; Denial	RELATING TO LIQUOR LICENSES.	Provides that the Liquor Commission or other licensing agency of each county shall deny the renewal of certain current liquor licenses upon receipt of sufficient protests.
<a href="#">SB2848</a>	Beer; Distilled Spirits; Direct Shipping; Manufacturers	RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR.	Allows direct shipment of beer and distilled spirits by certain licensees. Requires the Liquor Commission of each county to adopt rules and regulations.
<a href="#">HB159 HD1 SD1</a>	Liquor Licenses; Renewal of License; Elimination of Notarization Requirement	RELATING TO LIQUOR LICENSES.	Exempts the notarization requirement for renewals of liquor licenses. (SD1)
<a href="#">HB2624</a>	Liquor Tax Law; Rates; Substance Abuse Treatment	RELATING TO THE LIQUOR TAX LAW.	Establishes a substance abuse treatment special fund. Increases liquor tax rates to unspecified amounts. Allocates increased liquor tax revenues to the substance abuse treatment special fund.
<a href="#">HB2525</a>	Liquor Licenses; Renewal; Protest; Denial	RELATING TO LIQUOR LICENSES.	Provides that the Liquor Commission or other licensing agency of each county shall deny the renewal of certain current liquor licenses upon receipt of sufficient protests.
