Kaua'i Police investigating suspicious death in Kapa'a

LĪHU'E – Kaua'i Police are investigating the suspicious death of 52-year-old John Diaz Jr. of Kapa'a.

On Friday, Feb. 24, at approximately 10:30 p.m., officers responded to a report of an unconscious man with multiple injuries observed in the vicinity of north Kealia Beach. The victim was treated on scene before being transported by ambulance to Wilcox Memorial Center with lifethreatening injuries, where he later died.

Karl Tondevold, 48, of Nebraska and Christy Selvage, 43, of Kapa'a were arrested for Murder in the second degree in connection to the death of John Diaz Jr. Selvage was released pending investigation, and Tondevold is currently being held at KPD cellblock.
