- Beginner Class, Session 2: July 6 to July 29
 - Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday
 - Class is from 10 a.m. to 11 a.m.
 - Graduation is July 29, from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m.
- Advanced Class, Session 2: July 6 to July 29
 - Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday
 - Class is from 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

• Graduation is July 29, from 8 a.m. to 2 p.m.
