#### What's in -

Size: 2-liter (68 oz) or smaller

Drink: water, juice, soda, tea, coffee, sports drinks, beer, malt beverages, some mixed spirits (<15% alcohol), some

blended wines (<7% alcohol)

Material type: glass, plastic (#1 & 2 only), aluminum, bi-

metal

Labeled: HI 5¢

#### What's out -

Size: larger than 2-liters (gallon jugs)

**Drink:** wine, liquor, milk, concentrates meal supplements

## **How to Prepare HI 5 Containers: Remove Caps**

**Empty containers** 

No liquid, food or trash

From all bottles

Sort by material type

Plastic, glass, aluminum

and bi-metal

Crushina

Aluminum and plastic may be crushed.

Large loads

Residential loads of 1000+ containers can be brought to any redemption center Commercial loads can be taken to any redemption

center except Kōloa.

### How you're paid:

- No customer counts will be accepted. Customers may request a hand count of up to 200 beverage containers per redemption visit. After 200, materials may be weighed.
- Materials will be weighed and paid at the following State regulated rates:
  - Aluminum Cans: 32 units per lb. = \$1.60 per lb.
  - Bi-metal Cans: 5.9 units per lb. = \$.295 per lb.
  - Plastic Beverage Containers: 18.8 units per lb. = \$.94 per lb.
  - Small Plastic Beverage Containers (you have the option to sort out bottles 17 oz. or less for a higher payment): 26.3 units per pound = \$1.315 per lb.
  - Glass Beverage Bottles: 2.4 units per lb. = \$.12 per lb.

Customer refunds shall be in the form of cash or company checks ONLY-no IOU's! Note: 2-liter containers may be mixed in with the plastic containers or counted separately. (All information subject to change- last modified May 12, 2020)
