4)	That you will take such measures to prevent public inconveniences such as traffic delays caused by lane closures (half of the road to be opened at any given time), detours, or redirection of vehicular and pedestrian traffic around the work area. Good housekeeping practices shall be provided to minimize loose stone(s) left in the travel way that may become airborne causing safety hazard and to prevent tracking mud and gravel on the road pavement causing slippery, muddy, or dusty conditions. Prope safeguard structures and signage for vehicular and pedestrian traffic shall be provided over or along the excavated work area.				
5)	That you will be responsible for any additional repair work necessitated, or any and all liabilities caused, by or on account of th settling of the backfill for such excavation; and that you will be responsible for any damages caused to existing undergroun structures by the flow of traffic over same.
