



Mainline Routes



1 Later weekend service

Extend service later on Saturdays and Sundays



2 Hourly weekend service

Provide hourly service on Saturdays and Sundays



3 Less “out of service” time

Ensure last trips are inbound to reduce “out of service” time.



4 Later weekday service

Add a later weekday trip to north and west mainline routes



5 More weekday peak service

Add 30-minute service during weekday peak between Kalāheo and Kīlauea



6 More weekday midday service

Add 30-minute service during weekday peak between Kalāheo and Kīlauea

Shuttles

1



Līhu'e/Kōloa

Reorganize the Līhu'e and Kōloa shuttle routes to make them easier to understand and more reliable



Wailua

Add new service to Wailua (Route 800 and Route 850)

Waimea/ Hanapepe/‘Ele‘ele

Add new shuttle service to connect Waimea, Hanapepe, and ‘Ele‘ele

4



Partnerships

Continue working with businesses and resorts to establish shuttles in the North Shore, East Side, and South Shore

Not all 10 proposed strategies (6 for mainline routes, 4 for shuttles) can be implemented within our existing budget. As we create efficiencies in the system, we will implement strategies in the order listed above.

Paratransit

On-Demand Bus Service for People with Mobility Constraints



In-person assessments

Require in-person assessments for most cases



Fare incentives to use fixed-route

Increase single ride paratransit fare for non-ADA eligible riders to \$4

Increase single ride paratransit fare for ADA eligible riders to \$2



Changes to age eligibility

Increase age eligibility threshold to 65 years, with automatic ADA eligibility at 85 years



Trip limits for age eligible riders

Age eligible riders: 65 to 84 years of age

Limit age-eligible paratransit trips to 10 per month per person

Exceptions: Dialysis and work trips

Fares



No annual pass

Eliminate annual pass and instead pursue a bulk pass program




Increase price of monthly pass

Increase monthly pass cost by \$5 over the next two years (goal of \$50/month in two years)



Discounted fixed-route monthly pass

Create a discounted fixed-route monthly pass for seniors aged 65 years and over, people with disabilities, and youth (start at \$20, increase by \$5 in two years)



One-day pass

Create a \$4 one-day pass valid on all mainline and shuttle routes



10-ride paratransit pass

Eliminate paratransit monthly pass and create a 10-pass product (\$20 for ADA and \$40 for age-eligible)



Fixed-route ADA fare



Establish \$1 single trip fixed-route fare for people with disabilities


