# A BILL FOR AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT FOR BARGAINING UNIT 12 BETWEEN JULY 1, 2025 AND JUNE 30, 2029

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE COUNTY OF KAUA'I, STATE OF HAWAI'I:

SECTION 1. Sec. 19.13.B of the Charter of the County of Kaua'i, as amended ("Charter") provides that any contract or lease requiring the payment of funds from appropriations of more than one fiscal year shall be approved by ordinance.

As such, the following cost items for Bargaining Unit ("BU") 12 under Hawai'i Revised Statutes ("HRS") §89-6 are hereby approved for the period of July 1, 2025 through June 30, 2029:

#### BU-12:

- A. Effective July 1, 2025, salary increase shall be as follows:
  - Continue step movement plan; and
  - 5.00% across the board (ATB) increase.
- B. Effective July 1, 2026, salary increase shall be as follows:
  - Continue step movement plan;
  - 5.00% across the board (ATB) increase; and
  - All Unit 12 employees on salary ranges PO-7 to PO-15 shall receive a one-time lump sum retention bonus of one thousand eight hundred dollars (\$1,800).
- C. Effective July 1, 2027, salary increase shall be as follows:
  - Continue step movement plan; and
  - 5.00% across the board (ATB) increase.
- D. Effective July 1, 2028, salary increase shall be as follows:
  - Continue step movement plan; and
  - 5.00% across the board (ATB) increase.

Wage costs include fringe benefit costs representing expenses which automatically increase when base salaries increase (e.g. premium pay, overtime, Medicare, unemployment compensation, and leave benefits). The subsequent years' cost includes the rollover from the previous year (Exhibit A).

SECTION 2. If any provisions of this Ordinance or the application thereof to any persons or circumstance are held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of the Ordinance which can be given effect without the invalid provisions or application and, to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are severable.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect when the Maui County Council, the Honolulu City Council, the Hawai'i County Council, and the Kaua'i County Council have, pursuant to HRS §89-10(b), appropriated moneys for cost items for Bargaining Unit 12 for the period of July 1, 2025 to June 30, 2029.
