

## 2026 Mayor's Youth Track Meet

### Rules

- 1) Boy or Girl in Kindergarten – 5<sup>th</sup> grade. (Must be resident of the County of Kauai)
- 2) Participants can only enter their designated GRADE group.
- 3) Each participant can enter “3” individual events and be on a relay team.  
NO Relay teams for K-1
- 4) **SHOES are required:** All participants must wear shoes to participate in track meet. Shoes may have knobs or waffles.
- 5) **The only tents allowed will be those on event permit.**  
**NO Other tent/pop tents will be allowed.**  
**\*\*The venues do not allow tents/pop up tents in bleachers or on field\*\***
- 6) No starting blocks will be allowed.
- 7) For specific rules for events refer to Field Events and Running Events Rules.
- 9) Coach or school volunteer may bring their athletes to check in with “Clerk of the Course”. Once participants are acknowledged by the Clerk all coaches/school volunteers must exit the field. (if not assisting with getting runners to starting line)
- 10) Once the event is completed, no accommodation will be made to make up the event. It is the Coaches and Participants’ responsibility to listen to the call for all events.
- 11) Everyone should stay off track/field if they are not running, If you need to be on field please kneel or sit down.

FINAL RESULTS: For all events **the top six places** will be based on:

Field events: a) Standing Broad Jump – best distance b) Softball Throw – best distance

Elementary Division Running Events: best times: If an event has finals, it will be based on finals times only. **Preliminary heats for 50 yd dash & 100 yd dash WILL NOT be timed. Top 2 finishers in each heat will advance to finals.**

Awards will be given to individuals during the meet. We will not be doing school points this year since we must split the event. **There will be no overall winners.**
