

During an informational session held on January 12, 2026, an attendee asked if we could share the Five Year Homeless Strategic Plan. Although this is still in draft form, we have included the following taken from page 6 of the plan which outlines the community determined priorities that provide the guiding framework for the Request for Proposals:

Strategic Priorities*

This plan includes six strategic priorities to address existing issues affecting homeless residents and the homelessness services system. Specific goals, objectives, actions, and metrics for measuring progress are included for each priority. Priorities include:

1. strengthen coordination across and within the homelessness services system;
2. expand housing and shelter capacity;
3. improve data quality/access, reporting, and evaluation;
4. enhance equity and vulnerable population support;
5. expand prevention, outreach, and early intervention; and
6. increase community understanding, education, and involvement.
